I regret that I was unable to provide substantive answers to two written questions you tabled on 17 May. My answers are as follows.

**How is the Welsh Government ensuring the sustainability of rural fire and rescue stations?** (WQ92911)

This sustainability of rural fire and rescue stations is a complex and long-term problem which extends well beyond Wales, and which calls for creative thinking and possibly difficult choices. I will therefore be chairing a special meeting of our Social Partnership Forum for Fire and Rescue Services next month to discuss possible solutions.

**Will the Cabinet Secretary provide an update on the progress made from the thematic review of operational training within the Welsh Fire and Rescue Services report from October 2022?** (WQ92912)

The Chief Fire and Rescue Advisor's (CFRA) recommendations in the Welsh Fire and Rescue Services report from October 2022 aim to ensure firefighters receive high-quality training to operate safely and to protect people, property and the environment. All Services are in the process of implementing those recommendations.
